The Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct an 45 MW Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility in Kent County, Maryland (“Application”), which was filed on November 30, 2018, by Morgnec Road Solar LLC (“Applicant”). The Applicant is proposed to construct a 45 MW solar generating facility on two parcels totally approximately 253.16 acres of property (“Site”) in Kent County, Maryland. The Site borders the Town of Chestertown to the south, immediately adjacent to an area designated by Kent County as Priority Funding Area associated with the Town of Chestertown.

After review of the Application, the Commission hereby docketts the matter as Case No. 9499, sets the matter for hearing, and delegates the matter to the Public Utility Law Judge Division to conduct the proceedings.
