**NOTICE OF TECHNICAL CONFERENCE AND
REQUEST FOR COMMENTS**

On April 11, 2025, the Commission requested several reports to be filed within six months of the issuance of Order No. 91603¹ to start the information technology system and process planning and for all stakeholders to help develop a regulatory framework to implement FERC Order No. 2222 to speed the deployment of cost-effective virtual power plants that will benefit ratepayers. The Commission also stated in this Order that it will convene a future Technical Conference in 2025 in this matter after the receipt of various directed conceptual reports, while also providing stakeholders a notice for an opportunity to comment on those reports.

These reports were filed on October 11, 2025, by The Potomac Edison Company (“PE”),² Baltimore Gas and Electric Company (“BGE”), Potomac Electric Power Company (“Pepco”) and Delmarva Power & Light Company (“Delmarva Power”) (together with BGE, the “Exelon

Utilities),³ Southern Maryland Electric Coop., Inc. (“SMECO”),⁴ the Office of Staff Counsel (“Staff”)⁵ and the Maryland Interconnection Work Group Leader (“WG Leader”).⁶

The Commission invites interested stakeholders to file comments⁷ on these reports by Wednesday, November 19, 2025. Comments should be addressed to Andrew S. Heintz Hearing Room, 16th Floor, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, MD 21202.
